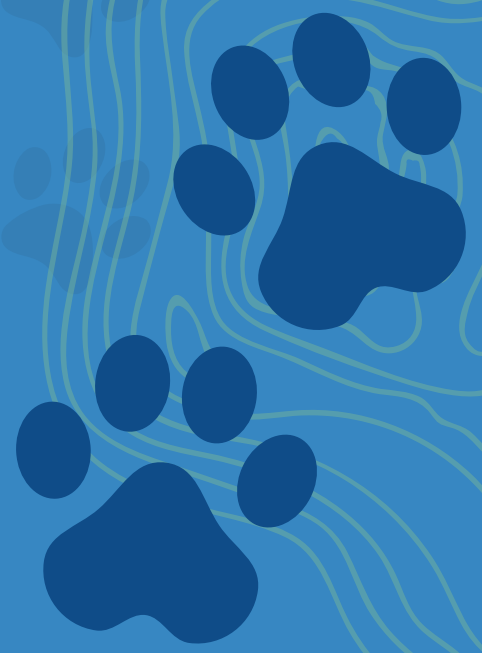

Pet waste is a major contributor to water pollution

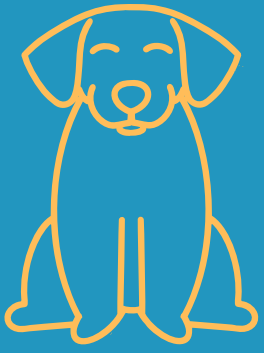

Why is dog poop different from other wildlife?



Dog food isn't sourced from the local environment and lots of dogs in an urban area contribute to excessive waste.

Dog poop contains bacteria and nutrients that can harm aquatic life and water quality.

Rain and snowmelt flows over yards, dog parks, and down trails on its way to storm drains. Water that enters a storm drain is not treated or cleaned before entering our rivers and lakes.



BE PREPARED

Carry poop bags with you



LEND A HAND

Take extra bags so you don't run out (and you can help someone in need)

USE THE TRASH

Make sure the bag ends up in the trash



PICK IT UP

Pick it up at home (and on the trail) to keep your yard healthy and protect streams
